BYLAW 12

Consolidated Copy (with amendments up to May 12, 1970)

A bylaw of the Summer Village of Ghost Lake relating to the parking of vehicles and/or trailers along the water front of the Village or in the direct approaches to the water front of the Village.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY and pursuant to the provisions of Section 296(a) of the Town and Village Act, 1952, the Council of the Summer Village of Ghost Lake enacts as follows:

- 1. That no vehicles will be parked along the water front or in any of the recognized approaches to the water front. This is to include all motor vehicles, carts, wagons or trailers.
- 2. That "NO PARKING" signs will be placed on the road to the water between Blocks 1 and 2 Plan 6490EL.
