FIRE ADVISORY

Fire Advisory– moderate fire danger. The Summer Village of Ghost Lake warns residents that forecasted hot dry conditions or a short-term concern like a major wind event may increase the fire hazard level and lead to a more restrictive fire ban. During a fire advisory, open fires are allowed, but residents are reminded to be extra vigilant.

Residents are reminded to always practice fire safety:

1. Soaking the area adjacent to the fire pit with water is recommended.
2. Closely supervise all outdoor fires. Make sure the fire fully extinguished and out, before leaving.
3. Supervise children around any fire outdoors, including campfires, fire pits, chimneys, and outdoor fireplaces.
4. Before starting a fire pit fire, have a bucket of water, or shovel and dirt or sand nearby to extinguish the fire.
5. To put out a fire pit fire...Soak it, stir it, soak it again.
