3.1 Carraig Ridge Well

Alberta Environment and Protected Areas (AEP) recently sent a letter to those who filed a Statement of Concern previously, indicating that a Preliminary Certificate has been granted to Carraig Ridge allowing a diversion of water for the purpose of a municipal potable water supply. This directly impacts the Village of Ghost Lake.
